# FAQ's

## **Can the workshops be run at the Highland Moss shop in Aberdeen?**

Yes! We can accommodate up to 6 people in our shop and run workshops at 7 PM. It's a cosy, creative space ideal for small groups.

## **Do you charge a travel fee for offsite workshops?**

Within Aberdeen, there is no travel fee. For locations outside the city, a travel fee may apply depending on the distance and number of participants.

## **What do we need at the venue to run the workshop?**

We simply need tables and chairs, enough space for materials and decorations, and access to a sink for water.

## **Do participants need any experience?**

Not at all! All our workshops are designed to be easy, fun, and relaxing, suitable for complete beginners and those with some plant experience.

## **Do you provide all materials?**

Yes. We bring everything needed for the workshop.

## Can you tailor the workshop for a special event or theme?

Yes, we're happy to customise decorations or workshop content to match your event theme.

# FAQ's

## Can we organise a workshop at your venue?

Yes! Our shop can accommodate 6 people for workshops such as terrarium, succulent garden, and moss art. These sessions are held after our regular opening hours at 7 PM. We provide a table and seating area for all participants and can also host a small display or welcome area.

For smaller botanical experiences like Marimo moss, mini terrariums, or wee succulent gardens, we can also host up to 6 people around our Botanical Lab table during opening hours.

Please note that these sessions take place while the shop is open, so there may be other customers around, and the workshop will be conducted standing at the table.
